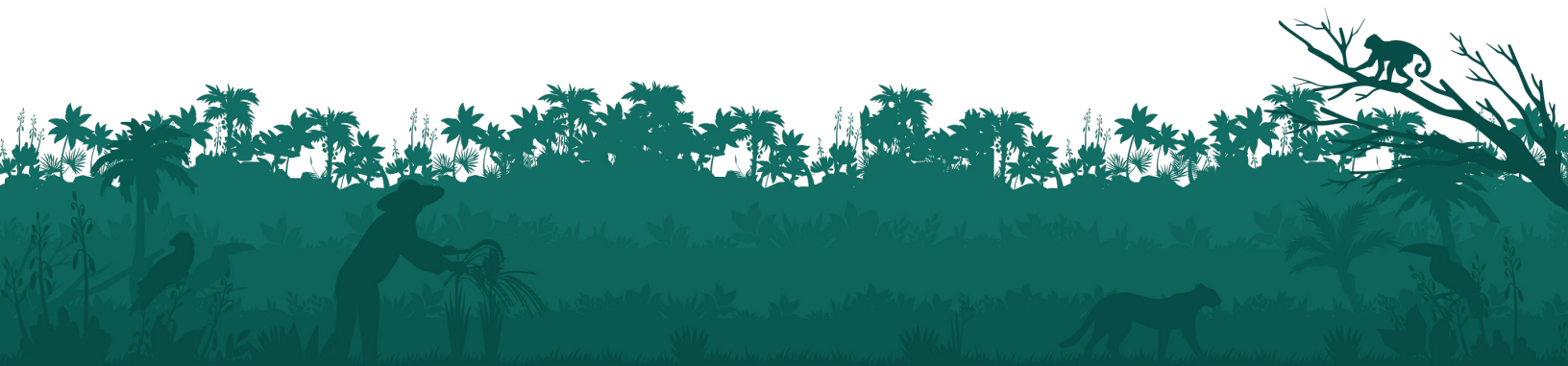

Secure Forest Communities' Rights & Livelihoods

Supporting Indigenous Peoples', Afro-Descendant Peoples', and local communities' efforts to secure and exercise their collective rights and land tenure, manage their forests, and support their livelihoods.



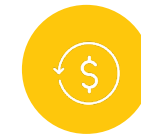
Advance Governance, Policy & Accountability

Supporting effective environmental and social governance and policies while strengthening accountability to ensure equitable and sustainable management of forest resources and a just energy transition.



Strengthen Movements, Narratives & Collective Action

Supporting resilient, inclusive movements, narratives, and collective action on justice and rights, forest protection and regeneration, and climate resilience.



Shift Financial Systems

Supporting just economic transitions that strengthen equity and transparency, revitalize forest economies, and reverse forest loss, while mobilizing more accessible and effective finance for forests and communities.



Improve Production, Consumption & Trade

Supporting shifts in agricultural production, consumption, and trade toward lower-emissions, climate-resilient alternatives that benefit people and the environment, and increasing the sustainability of infrastructure and extractive industries in ways that protect communities and nature.

Where We Focus

We focus our grantmaking on tropical forest regions with significant potential for addressing the climate crisis and preserving cultural and biological diversity, and on the global policies and practices impacting forest communities.



Brazil

We support efforts to conserve the Amazon and the Cerrado biomes; to ensure Indigenous Peoples', Afro-Descendant Peoples', local communities' and family farmers' land rights are secure and freely exercised; and to advance climate-resilience, forest economies, equity, and well-being through sustainable land use.



Colombia & Peru

We support efforts to conserve and restore Colombia and Peru's tropical forest systems; to ensure Indigenous Peoples, Afro-Descendant Peoples, and local communities secure and freely exercise their territorial and environmental rights; and to strengthen civil society and governance for greater equity and climate resilience.



Indonesia

We support efforts to halt deforestation, and protect and restore Indonesia's forest ecosystems, while respecting Indigenous Peoples' and local communities' rights, and building a climate-resilient, inclusive, and just restorative economy.



Mexico & Central America

We support efforts to reverse deforestation, build climate resilience, and strengthen Indigenous Peoples', Afro-Descendant Peoples' and local communities' rights through transforming territorial to regional governance across Mexico and Central America.



Global

We support efforts to strengthen international and driver economy policies, financial flows, and narratives to halt and reverse forest loss as part of a just and climate-resilient world.
